



Report: 1790 Cincinnati 9- Detroit Waza Flo Pro 4

Fairfield, OH- The Detroit Waza Flo Pro fell to 1790 Cincinnati 9-4 in its inaugural Professional Arena Soccer League Pro (PASL- Pro) match.

Player/coach Dominic Scicluna scored the first goal in Detroit Waza Flo Pro history 9:58 seconds into the first quarter.

Cincinnati jumped out to a 4-1 first quarter lead, but two goals from Daniel Trosper and a Ryan Montague strike brought Waza within one at 5-4 early in the third quarter.

The match was played at a fast pace with high quality technique from both sides. At 5-4 it was anybody's match, but Garrett Buck restored the two goal advantage for the home side with 9:15 left in the third stanza.

The score-line could have been easier on the eyes for the motor city fans, but down 7-4, Waza pulled their keeper in favor of a sixth attacker and duly conceded two empty net goals. "I'd rather go down fighting to score," Waza head coach Dominic Scicluna remarked after the match. "It doesn't matter whether you're losing by one goal, or two goals or three goals, you're still losing!"

The Waza Flo Pro will be back in action this weekend as it continues its six game road hull to start the season with matches versus the Denver Dynamite (Nov 15) and the Colorado Lightning (Nov 16).
