



Preview: Detroit v. Denver Dynamite and Colorado Lightning

Detroit Waza Flo Pro heads to Colorado this weekend for matches with the Denver Dynamite (Saturday, 7:15 P.M.) and the Colorado Lightning (Sunday, 6:00 P.M.)

Following its 9-4 loss to Cincinnati last weekend, the team has been hard at work on the training ground in preparation for its trip to the Mile High City. "We focused on power plays, both man up and man down," Mario Scicluna said at the end of practice. "We've also worked on tighter marking off restarts."

Scicluna says Waza will not have their full squad this weekend as midfielder Tommy Eller is out with a foot injury. The team will also be without the services of midfielder Daniel Troser and goalkeepers Anthony Santili Ryan Mathe. Rookie Wes Giachetti will step into the net for this weekend's double header.

Waza will serve as the home opener for the Dynamite, which has not played since its double header with Calgary two weekends ago. The Dynamite fell 5-3 and 5-2 to Calgary United. Following its 0-2 start, the team replaced Mike Thompson as head coach and installed Major Indoor Soccer League veteran Chris Handsor as a player/coach.

Colorado is also 0-2, losing the first ever PASL- Pro match on October 25 to the Stockton Cougars and dropping a 5-8 decision to the Texas Outlaws in their home opener. The Lightning added midfielder Josh Elbaum to their squad this week. The Oregon State University product spent time with the San Diego Sockers from 2003 to 2004 and had a stint with the Colorado Rapids in 2005.
