



Match Report: West Virginia Quantum Force 10- Detroit Waza 11

The Detroit Waza Flo Pro is back in the win column with a thrilling 11-10 overtime victory over the West Virginia Quantum Force.

Blake Ordell had a massive night with four goals and three assists and Darrel Quinn chipped in with a hat trick as Waza hit double figures for the first time this season.

Head Coach Dominic Scicluna enjoyed his return to action with three assists and assistant coach Gronthik Chatterjee also got in on the act with his first goal of the season.

Gabe Hernandez and Hugo Sanchez also enjoyed strong nights as both players opened their PASL-Pro accounts. Hernandez found the net twice and Sanchez deserved his goal for solid displays in both matches this weekend.

Waza took a 2-0 lead only for the Quantum Force to fire off the next four goals. Waza then went ahead 6-4 only for the two teams to trade goals and leave Waza with a 10-8 advantage with under two minutes left.

West Virginia pulled to within one goal with under a minute left but then took a penalty when Jayson Pandell kicked Ordell behind the play. Despite being a man down, West Virginia scored a short handed goal with under 30 seconds to go to force overtime.

Ordell was the hero during the sudden death overtime as he slammed home a rebound following a melee in front of the net as Waza finally broke its goose egg on the road at the final time of asking.
