



Match Report: Detroit Waza Flo Pro 11 - West Virginia Quantum Force 6 *Waza sweeps the season series*

The Detroit Waza Flo Pro recorded its third victory of the season with a comfortable 11-6 Victory over the West Virginia Quantum Force at Compuware Arena.

Waza dominated the game in terms of possession, but the score was close as the teams went into the final quarter with Waza holding a slim 7-5 advantage. Waza broke away in the fourth quarter with goals from Tom Stark and Tommy Eller extending the lead to 9-5. West Virginia pulled one back through Columbian midfielder Joan Gallego, but Waza's Derek Garrambone and Blake Ordell scored late in the game to secure all three points for the home side.

Ordell recorded three goals and one assist and now heads the Waza scoring chart with 10 goals in 11 games this season. In the two wins over West Virginia, Ordell has seven goals and 4 assist.

"In both games they gave me a lot of space on the ball," Ordell said when asked why he was so effective against the Quantum Force. "With that kind of time I was able to turn with the ball and pick my spots."

Tommy Eller chipped in with two goals and Derek Garrambone and Pat Griffen both scored their first goals of the season for the Motor City Boys.

Joan Gallego and Eugene Brooks scored two goals apiece to pace West Virginia.

The win over West Virginia not only counts towards the PASL- Pro standings, but also as a US Open Cup match.

Waza next match against 1790 Cincinnati on January 25 at 1:00 P.M. at Compuware Arena will be both a regular season tilt and a quarter-final US Open Cup match.
