

Waza FC Membership and Dues Payment Agreement



We fully understand and consent to the following terms and conditions regarding the Waza FC (hereafter, referred to as "Waza") costs as outlined and estimated on the team commitment form (hereafter, referred to as "costs") and the Waza membership obligations and privileges:

1. In accordance with the Waza bylaws, failure to pay the entire 2008-2009 costs by the applicable due dates may result in suspension of membership in Waza. The continued failure to pay the required dues for a period of thirty (30) days will result in automatic loss of membership standing and we will no longer be able to participate in the Waza programs and activities.
2. If we withdraw or drop out of the Waza program for any reason whatsoever, we are not entitled to any refund of dues previously paid and we remain responsible to the Waza for the entire season's costs.
 - a. Waza reminds all parents of U14 Players that the U14's are a full year team (fall, winter and spring). If a player elects to play for a high school team, the family is still responsible for the entire year's share of all fees and expenses associated with the running of the team. Including, but not limited to: coaching fees, club and association dues, field use fees, tournament fees, etc....incurred during the high school season.
3. We are responsible for the entire season's costs even if the Waza shall in its sole discretion provide its members with a payment plan option.
4. If we default in payment of our costs for any reason whatsoever, we are liable for all costs involved in collecting such entire season's dues, including, but not limited to, the Waza reasonable attorney's fees and associated costs.
